

Gunning Wind Farm Scholarship

ACCIONA Energy has built and owns three wind farms in Australia, one through a joint venture, and has developed a strong pipeline of projects for construction. The wind farms at Mt Gellibrand and Waubra in Victoria, Gunning in New South Wales, Cathedral Rocks in South Australia and Mortlake South in Victoria, which has just began construction will produce the energy equivalent to the needs of over 400,000 households.

The Gunning Wind Farm is located 15kms northeast of Gunning. The turbines are located on privately owned land, on a property called 'Walwa'.

The scholarship is open to all students from the local area wishing to enter further study in TAFE or University in 2019.

Eligibility and Payment Criteria

- All students residing in the Upper Lachlan Shire NSW, enrolled in university or TAFE in 2019, are eligible to apply.
- Applicants who are offered an ACCIONA Scholarship will be required to provide proof of enrolment in 2019 and also provide evidence of mid year pass grades in subjects studied. Scholarship payments will be allocated in two instalments. One payment of \$2500 when proof of enrolment is produced and another payment of \$2500 when half yearly results are produced.
- Selection of the successful candidates will be made according to academic merit, financial need and with reference to applicant's written statement (500 words) regarding their school activities and responsibilities, community involvement and future career aspirations.
- Successful applicants may be required to attend media events as required.
