#### NOTICE OF VARIATION OF LICENCE NO. 20533

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. ACCIONA INFRASTRUCTURE AUSTRALIA PTY LTD ("the licensee") is the holder of Environment Protection Licence No. 20533 ("the licence") issued under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* ("the Act"). The licence authorises the carrying out of activities at PACIFIC HIGHWAY, NAMBUCCA HEADS, NSW, 2448 ("the premises").
- B. On 29-Mar-2017 the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) received an application for the variation of the licence.

The application sought to include 5 areas within the premise boundary, these include:

- An additional area at the northern end of Albert Drive (approximate chainage 46,900 map 5) to allow for a heavy vehicle trun around bay;
- An additional area to allow for heavy vehicle access a private residence via a driveway on the Bonnett-Donelly private property (between approximate chainage 56,400 to 56,500 map 13);
- An additional area to allow construction of the Marino private property access (chainage 56,680 map 13);
- An additional area to allow works to be undertaken to repair a private property dam spillway (approximate chainage 55,400 - map 12) and augmentation of a drainage line (approximate chainage 55850 - map 12) to mitigate construction and operation impacts due to cross drainage arrangements at this location.

A series of revised premise maps was provided (identified as the Pacific Highway Upgrade WC2NH EPL Rev 17, 9 March 2017) to the EPA which includes the requested changes to the premise boundary.

C. The EPA reviewed the application, considered the matters identified in section 45 of the Act and is satisfied that the variation requested has been approved in accordance with the Environmental

Planning and Assessment Act 1979 and can be managed in a manner which will provide an appropriate level of environmental protection.

D. The EPA has therefore approved the application.

#### **VARIATION OF LICENCE NO. 20533**

- 1. By this notice the EPA varies licence No. 20533. The attached licence document contains all variations that are made to the licence by this notice.
- 2. The following variations have been made to the licence:
  - The EPL premise boundary has been amended to include an area at the northern end of Albert Drive to allow for construction of a heavy vehicle turn around bay;
  - The EPL premise boundary has been amended to allow for construction of heavy vehicle access to a private residence via a driveway on the Bonnett-Donnelly private property. This is subject to Acciona gaining written agreement from the landowner for the works to proceed;
  - The EPL premise boundary has been amended to allow for construction of the Marino private property access;
  - The EPL premise boundary has been amended to allow works to be undertaken to repair a private property dam spillway, and augmentation of a drainage line to mitigate construction and operation impacts due to cross drainage arrangements at this location.
  - Condition A2.2 was amended to reflect the current set of approved maps.
