NOTICE OF VARIATION OF LICENCE NO. 20533

BACKGROUND

- A. ACCIONA INFRASTRUCTURE AUSTRALIA PTY LTD ("the licensee") is the holder of Environment Protection Licence No. 20533 ("the licence") issued under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* ("the Act"). The licence authorises the carrying out of activities at PACIFIC HIGHWAY, NAMBUCCA HEADS, NSW, 2448 ("the premises").
- B. On 02-Mar-2018 the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) received an application for the variation of the licence. The application sought to vary the licence in the following manner:
- Reduce the activity scale for 'land based extractive activity' from 'more than 2,000,000 tonnes extracted processed or stored' to 'more than 100,000 tonnes but not more than 500,000 tonnes extracted processed or stored';
 - Reduce the activity scale for 'crushing, grinding or separating' from more than 500,000 tonnes but not more than 2,000,000 tonnes annual processing capacity' to more than 30,000 tonnes but not more than 100,000 tonnes annual processing capacity'.

VARIATION OF LICENCE NO. 20533

1. By this notice the EPA varies licence No. 20533. The attached licence document contains all variations that are made to the licence by this notice.
2. The following variations have been made to the licence:
 - Licence condition A1.1 has been varied to reflect the applicable fee-based activity scale / capacity

- If an appeal is made against this decision to vary the licence and the Land and Environment Court directs that the decision is stayed the decision does not operate until the stay ceases to have effect or the Land and Environment Court confirms the decision or the appeal is withdrawn (whichever occurs first).
